Course Overview

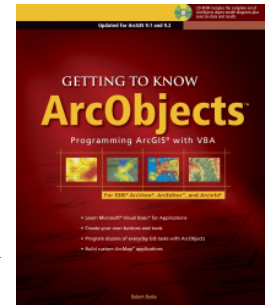
